# STARRY 2017 SERVICES REPORT

#### **COUNSELING**

STARRY continues to be one of the leading providers of counseling services to children and families across the state of Texas. This year, STARRY Counseling had the most substantial growth in the history of the program! Our licensed counseling staff provided more than 30,000 hours of professional counseling to children and families at no cost to them. Over 70 percent of the families we served were completely out of options and had no other resources available to them. But STARRY was able to offer help in their darkest hours!

#### **OPERATION STRONG FAMILIES**

In its second year, STARRY's Operation Strong Families (OPSF) program served active duty, reserve, National Guard, retiree, and veteran military families in the Killeen community. Our Military Family Specialists met with families in-home or at the office for monthly or bi-monthly visits depending on the family's needs. These essential support services are provided to families at no cost and without a referral.

#### **FOSTER CARE & ADOPTION**

STARRY's Foster Care and Adoption program continues to make a difference by providing safe, loving homes where children who have suffered from abuse or neglect are loved, nurtured, and given the chance to succeed. Did you know that the average foster family stays with an agency in Texas for about 7 months? However, STARRY foster families stay with us for an average of 3 years. We are grateful to have such strong program leadership and, this year, we saw the greatest results of the last 5 years!

#### TBRI® TRAINING

All STARRY staff is trained in Trust-Based Relational Intervention® (TBRI®), which helps to meet the needs of the body, soul, and spirit of children by using the principles of connecting, empowering, and correcting. This year we piloted our TBRI® Coaching program that allows all foster parents to have in-home TBRI® instruction and support, as well as access to a TBRI® professional in real-time. In addition, STARRY continues to grow in influence by training key community leaders in trauma-informed approaches.
